News About Alumni:

A recent letter from Edward A. Morris '51, was so interesting and informative we felt we should pass it along. . . . "Since I always look forward to your News Bulletin, especially 'News About Alumni', it may be of interest to classmates that I was fortunate in having my design chosen for the 1962-63 Federal Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp. It was the first time that any contestant won two years consecutively. The new stamp will be released July 1, and at that time subject matter will be released for the 1963-64 stamp. This information can be had by writing the United States Department of the Interior, Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington 25, D. C.

"Since many of the graduates are interested in earning a living, I will mention that *The Crossroads of Sport* and Abercrombie and Fitch sell prints of the stamp design. These are stone litho or dry point etchings, etc., and the artist realizes a profit from the sale of these prints to collectors. From the government you receive a folder with a sheet of the stamps autographed by the Postmaster General and the Secretary of the Interior. The contest is open to National competition and last year had one hundred and twenty-seven entries.

"The series started in 1934 with the late 'Ding' Darling being commissioned to create the first stamp. Since then many 'names' in the art field have appeared in connection with the stamp, among them, Richard E. Bishop, Lynn Bogue Hunt, Francis Lee Jacques and Maynard Reece."
