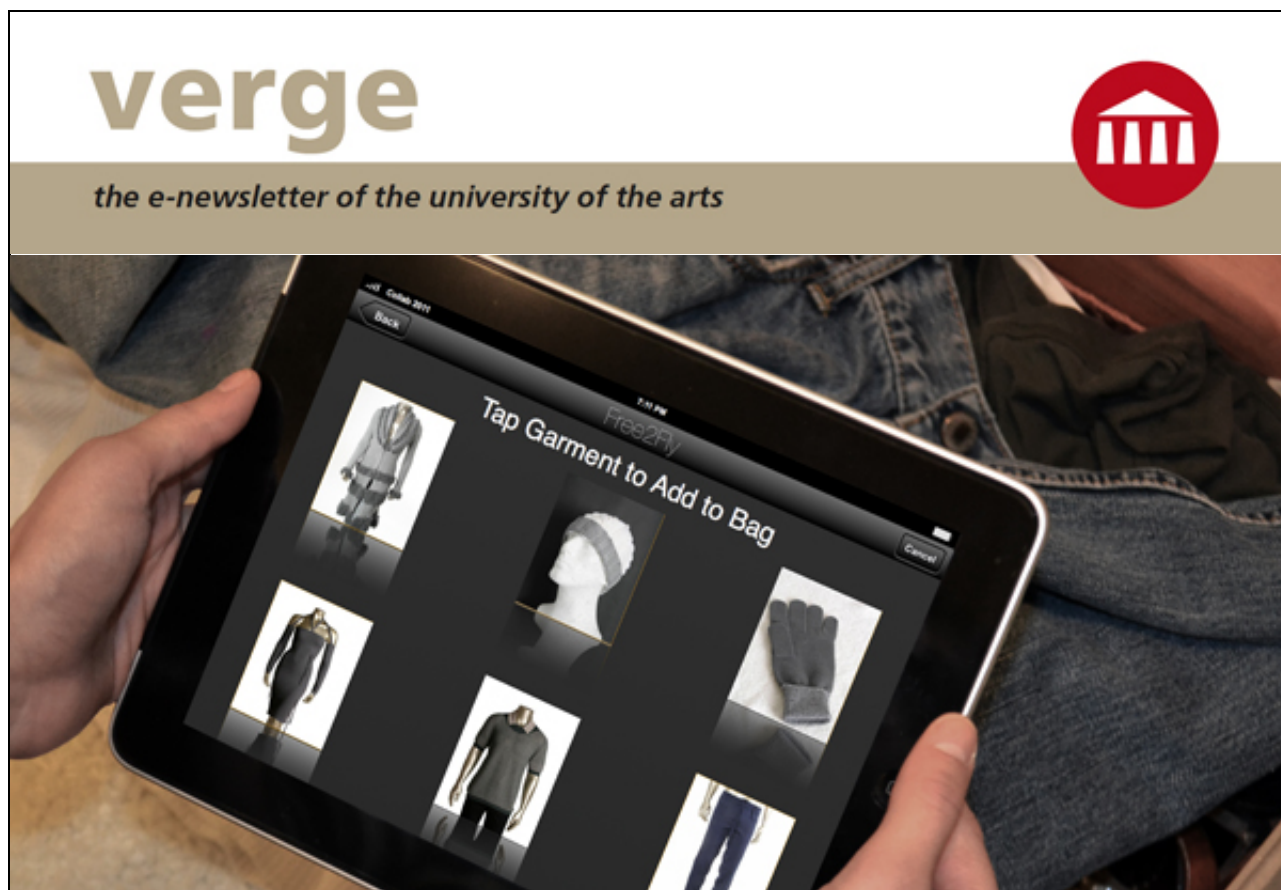

### Industrial Design Student's 'Digital Suitcase Solution' Is a Winning Design

The [2011 Collab Student Design Competition](#), held in conjunction with the [Philadelphia Museum of Art](#), created its first ever "Collab Choice Award" for the

Free2Fly app (pictured top) designed by University of the Arts student **Eduardo Calmon BS '13 (Industrial Design)**. Students were challenged with designing an overnight bag inspired by this year's recipient of the museum's Design Excellence Award: groundbreaking architect and jetsetter **Zaha Hadid**. Instead of a bag, Calmon created Free2Fly, which he calls a "digital suitcase solution." The app suggests garments based on the weather forecast at a traveler's destination and then transmits files to a knitting machine near the traveler's hotel, which produces garments that are available on arrival.

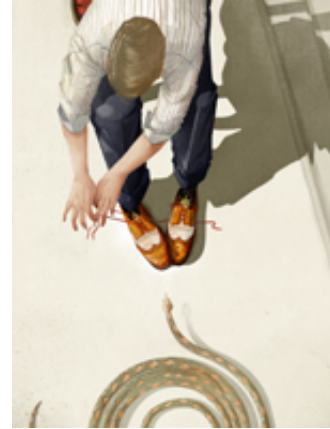
